

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY MEETING  
JANUARY 2, 2001  
TIME: 9:00A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Bailey and John Pratt. Bob Bostic was absent.

Darren Burkhart of HNTB gave an update on Main Street Sewer Replacement project. Change order no. 1 was submitted for approval in the amount of \$28,351.81. This change order was for additional work to install 6-inch house service laterals and they encountered an existing 18" storm sewer that was not shown on the plans that had to be repaired costing \$2590.87. Realignment of sanitary sewer between manholes #1 and #2 and to avoid potential collapse, manhole #1 had to be relocated and core drillings had to be done costing \$549.06. The installation of detour signage resulted in changes to correct a possible unclear detour routing costing \$611. The City of Greensburg requested additional State Road 46 signs to local detour costing \$1303.28. The restoration will be done in the Spring by the City with a decrease in cost being \$3000. Void areas were encountered in three locations during installation of sanitary sewers costing \$2916. Final measured quantities of completed work and state highway pavement repair, local street asphalt pavement repair, and local alley stone repair cost \$23,381.60.

**Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve Change Order No. 1. So passed.**

Fire Chief Dan Manus told the Board that probationary firefighters Troy Harmon and Ron Reynolds will have completed their year on January the 4<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of 2001 and Dan is asking that Troy and Ron be moved to first Class Firefighters as of January 4<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Dan stated they have done a very good job.

**Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to promote Troy and Ron to first class firefighters as of their respective dates. So passed.**

Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent Jeff Smith brought the authorization to discharge permit contract for Delta Faucet Corporation for the Board to sign.

Jeff also talked to the Board of a GPS System that he would like for updating the mapping of sewer lines and other areas. Jeff will set up a demonstration with a vendor after next months meeting.

Jeff told the Board of Roger Linkmeyer passing his test and acquiring his Certification.

Rick Pleak brought in a Deed of Dedication of the streets, rights-of-way and storm sewers in the Mill Ridge Estates Subdivision. Mr. Pleak was asking the City to accept and take these over.

Ralph Land Street Commissioner stated that he would like to see this finished first because his department cannot take care of it the way it is right now. Mr. Pleak stated the paving would be done in the Spring and would have Ralph to oversee when this is done.

**Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to the Deed of Dedication with the paving to be done in the Spring and Street Superintendent Ralph Land to oversee. So passed.**

**Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to award the Gasoline Bid to Premier Ag Co-op. So passed.**

Police Chief Keith Gay told the Board of having an officer in the schools and programs being set up. Keith stated the grant has been applied for again after being turned down the first time. At present Copple is working with the grades Kindergarten thru 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. Keith told of Jeff Porter working the Sergeant position and Denny Blodgett working the Lieutenant position since last November without extra pay. Keith stated he would like to move them into these positions permanently and would like for them to be paid for these positions. John Pratt stated that he would like more information before taking action and then would possibly make it retroactive in order to pay from January 2001.
