

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY MEETING
NOVEMBER 4, 2005
TIME: 8:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Frank Manus, Glenn Tebbe and Mike Riley.

All recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes were approved.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve sewer adjustment in the amount of \$964.95 for account #105779 on water bill. So passed.

Fire Chief Scott Chasteen request to demo and remove the vacant house behind the Fire Station. Scott had four quotes, 1. Vanderbur Excavating \$8,750; 2. Alpha Excavating \$7,949; 3. Gunter Excavating \$8,000; 4. Allen's Excavating \$9,500.

Scott asks to take the lowest quote being Alpha Excavating as long as they will disperse of the contents and take all to the landfill, if they will not agree to these stipulations then Scott would like to go with Gunter Excavating, because they specify that they will dispose of contents at the landfill.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the lowest quote to Alpha Excavating with stipulations that they will dispose of contents at the landfill otherwise Scott is to go with Gunter Excavating. So passed.

Scott requested to replace the current 12.5 KW back-up generator that was installed in 1975, with a new diesel 40 KW unit. The quotes were from 1. Brehob and Gaylor for \$25,855.50 and 2. Cummins Mid-States Power, Inc. for \$29,305.

Scott recommended going with the lowest quote being Brehob and Gaylor for \$25,855.50 and it has a five-year warranty.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the lowest quote. So passed.

Scott requested to purchase a heavy duty air compressor. The compressor that they have is not capable of providing pressures needed for the large vehicles. Quotes were from 1. Tops Hardware Porter-cable 7hp 80 gal 240v for \$788; 2. Northern Tool + Equipment 5hp 80 gal. 230v for \$1699.99 and 3. Northern Tool + Equipment 7.5hp 80 gal 230v for \$1599.99.

Scott recommended taking the lowest quote being Tops Hardware for \$788.

Motion by Mike Riley and seconded by Glenn Tebbe to approve the lowest quote. So passed.

Scott requested to purchase (8) sets of Globe G-extreme fire protective clothing from Hoosier Fire Equipment of Indianapolis. The cost per set (coats, pants and suspenders) is \$1233.93 for a total of \$9871.44.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the purchase. So passed.

Scott also requested to purchase 12 – 50ft. sections of 2-1/2 inch fire hose to replace hose lost during the annual fire hose test. Quotes were from: 1. Hoosier Fire Equipment for \$115.40 per section or a total of \$1384.80; 2. Southwestern Fire and Safety, Inc. for \$144 per section or a total of \$1728.

Scott recommended the lowest quote being Hoosier Fire Equipment for \$1384.80.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the lowest quote. So passed.

Motion by Mike Riley and seconded by Glenn Tebbe to approve the Supplemental Agreement between the City of Greensburg and Janssen and Spaans, Inc. related to the development of improvement of the segment of Vandalia Road between the corporate limits at Muddy Fork Sand Creek and SR 421. So passed.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the Lease Agreement between the City of Greensburg and Vincent J. and John Springmeyer. So passed.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the purchase of a pole camcorder for the Street Department. So passed.

The take home vehicles were discussed. Glenn Tebbe recommended a five mile out of the City maximum and may even need to be less than that. Glenn would like to see all the police cars be kept in the city limits.

Mike Riley would like to have input of what the State and State Police do in regard to charging the take home vehicle as a taxable benefit.

Scott Chasteen has taken the prospective new firefighter for physical.

Lincoln Street was discussed and Darren Burkhart told the Board that the State will probably want the water line put in outside of the roadway which is going to mean extra right-away.
