RE: OPENING OF GASOLINE BIDS
CONTRACT FOR WASTEWATER PLANT

Bids were opened from Preimer Ag and Kiel Brothers. Kathy Crippen, Ralph Land and City Attorney Frank I. Hamilton, Jr. will review the bids to see that all specs are met and who is the lowest on each item. Bids will be awarded January 2, 2001 at the Board of Works meeting.

Darren Burkhart and Roger Ward of HNTB were present. Bill Read of Bingman, Longest and Neft was present.

Mayor Bailey stated that he is a little more comfortable with HNTB and the knowledge they have of the City and the fact that they were responsible for the last upgrade done at the Wastewater Plant.

John Pratt wanted to know how the firms come up with the contract cost. Darren Burkhart of HNTB explained they take into consideration the specs, time, complexity of project as well as basing on other similar projects and several other factors. HNTB put in a not to exceed. Bill Read stated basically the same as HNTB. They would pass onto the City whatever the Shop Cost Review would be.

Bob Bostic stated after reviewing and hearing both firms proposals, he feels HNTB would be the firm to go with knowing their history and resumes and their knowledge of Greensburg.

Motion by Bob Bostic and seconded by John Pratt to award to HNTB the contract for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion and to sign the Contract. So passed.

Darren Burkhart brought up the advertising to be done December 28th. **Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Bob Bostic to approve and signed for the advertising. So passed.**
