

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY MEETING
 December 4, 2001, 2001
 TIME: 9:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Bailey and Bob Bostic.

Minutes were approved.

Mayor told the Board that he had gotten back the model on the Fairview Drainage from the Hydrologist and they would send out letters to the residents and have a meeting scheduled in January 2002 at City Hall.

Mayor Bailey stated that he has appointed Herb Hunter, Councilman, as the new Board of Works member and Mr. Hunter had accepted. Mr. Hunter will begin as of January 2002.

Wastewater superintendent Jeff Smith brought 3 quotes asking for the purchase of a vehicle to be used when going to seminars and meetings. There are usually several people that attend the seminars and meetings and they have had to use the pick-up trucks. This would keep the pick-up trucks in town and not cause a shortage at the plant. Jeff stated that this vehicle would be available to be used by other departments as well as the Mayor and Kathy Crippen.

The quotes were as follow: 1. Al Reynolds \$21,620 2. Don Meyer \$18,332 and 3. Rick Acra \$18,411.58.

Jeff ask to purchase the lowest quote.

Motion by Bob Bostic and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve the lowest quote being Don Meyer. So passed.

Jeff stated Fairview is not fixed yet, but he is working on that.

Clerk-Treasurer came before the Board to request the purchase of a copier. Quotes were from Jackson's Office Supply and The Office Shop. A spread-sheet was made up on the quotes given and supplied to the Board.

Quotes were as follows: 1. Jackson's Office Supply \$9232.90 and 2. The Office Shop \$6570. Request to purchase the lowest quote.

Motion by Bob Bostic and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve the lowest quote being The Office Shop. So passed.

Jennifer from ARA of Columbus was present about the Senior Center grant being applied for. Grant is through the Department of Commerce is for \$500,000. No City monies will be used to pay the ARA fee of \$46,000. The environmental fee will be \$3000. Steve Barth is drawing up the plans. The City is going to buy the ground with Edit money and pay the utilities for the Senior Center. December 17th, is the opening of bids at 2:00 P.M. at City Hall.

Motion by Bob Bostic and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve the agreement with ARA. So passed.
