

BOARD OF WORKS MEETING - SPECIAL
AUGUST 18, 2006
TIME: 8:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Frank Manus, Mike Riley and Glenn Tebbe.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Street Pavement Bids were opened from the following companies:

1. Koors Contracting – Westport, In. - \$258,668.13 and Bid Bond was included.
2. Myers – Westport, In. - \$266,020.61 and Bid Bond was included.
3. Dave O'Mara – North Vernon, In. - \$228,059.50 and Bid Bond was included.
4. Paul Rohe – Aurora, In. - \$216,175.18 and Bid Bond was included.
5. Milestone – Columbus, In. - \$328,884.37 and Bid Bond was included.

Bids will be reviewed by City Attorney and Street Superintendent Ralph Land and will be awarded at the next Board of Works meeting.

Jeff Smith Wastewater Superintendent requested purchasing two trench boxes with the purchase price for both being \$5603. Right now, this has to be contracted out and the cost runs between \$8000 - \$9000 each time. These are 8ft. safety shields and Jeff recommends purchasing the Aqua Laser.

Motion by Glenn Tebbe and seconded by Mike Riley to approve the purchase requested by Jeff Smith Wastewater Superintendent. So passed.

Mayor Manus told the Board that he had a quote of \$560 to wash the windows at Billings. The other quote was \$800 and he is going with the low quote.

Mayor stated that now someone is needed to do all the other cleaning. He thought the contractor would leave it as it was when they went in, but they didn't.

Still need four new doors and some glass replaced.

We will start having our meetings at the New City Hall October 1st.

An open house will be about two months later.

Glenn Tebbe asked about the old senior center and where we stand with that. City Attorney Steve Taylor that the attorneys are in negotiations with the insurance company.

The cost to clean up is a little over \$500,000. Steve Taylor explained the process and the possibilities of getting this all done.

Mayor told the Board that two appraisals will be needed for the existing City Hall and then will either take bids or have a sale. The building is on the Historical Register.

Ralph Land has a 1984 paving roller and has been offered \$1200 and would like to sell it. The Board told him that it will need to be advertised before it can be sold.
