

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY MEETING

August 04, 2003
Time: 9:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Bailey, Herb Hunter and Bob Bostic.

Minutes were approved.

Representatives from Elwood Staffing gave a presentation about their proposal to the City on recruiting and temporary or temp to hire positions and the cost and what they would receive for the cost.

Board thanked them for coming and stated they would review their proposal.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Bob Bostic to award to the lowest bidder being Tom Poole Construction from Dillsboro, In., the construction of the Greensburg Senior Citizens Center, upon the contract signing and release of funds from the State. So passed.

Water Superintendent Rick Denney stated he has talked to all the property owners except for one about water line easements for the project on west main street. Rick had easements to be signed by the Board.

Work was done on Park Road and around the Ryle Addition entrance to help on the drainage issue. Engineering firm is looking at the problem at Fairview . A new pipe needs to be put in out at Fairview .

Motion by Bob Bostic and seconded by Herb Hunter to approve adjustments on sewer portions of water bills for Norman Ogden \$31.94 and Willard Anderson \$57.41. So passed.

Darren Burkhart of HNTB gave the progress report on the Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements. Darren told the Board there is one more change order coming and hopefully the final completion papers will be ready for next months meeting.

Mayor told the Board the GIS was put on line last week and approximately 10 people were put through a training for it.

Street Superintendent Ralph Land told the Board that the 1995 ten yard Small Diesel Garbage truck is about to give out completely on them. It is grinding metal to metal and they are trying to keep it working, but don't know for how long. The truck is good the packer is bad on it.

Ralph ask permission to be able to advertise for bids for a new 20 yard packer garbage truck. This would be a lot heavier and would not have to make so many trips to the landfill. Ralph told the Board that he would like to keep the truck and take off the packer and put a regular dump bed on it and he would have another

needed dump truck as well as the ability to put a snow plow on the front for use in the winter time.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Bob Bostic to approve bids and expenditure. So passed.
