

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY MEETING
AUGUST 7, 2000
TIME: 9:00A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Bailey and John Pratt. Bob Bostic was absent.

Minutes were approved.

Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve sewer adjustments to Richard Acra \$65.36, Dennis Martin \$49.67, John Tumilty \$37.14 and Tim Wallace \$32.33. So passed.

Joe Shields came before the Board about the sewer surcharge on his water bill. Joe is asking for the surcharge to be dropped. After discussion it was decided to table this until the City Attorney Frank I. Hamilton, Jr. could review this situation and the ordinance.

Joe Shields also brought up about his water pressure. He was told that this would need to go before the water board. Mayor stated that he would have Rick Denney water superintendent to check this out before the water board meeting.

Darren Burkhart of HNTB gave the progress report on the Gas Creek Interceptor Sewer Extension – Phase 2. A change order in the amount of \$12,127.47 was brought before the board. The change order has to do with 1. 2 – 8” sewer line stub outs, 2. line be modified and lowered and had to change one manhole, 3. miss-calculation of a water line, 4. to relocate a 6” sting water line and 5. paving a patch on the street that the city requested.

Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve change order for \$12,127.47. So passed.

Darren stated on the Main Street Sewer Replacement, the schedule has been handed out, route has been video taped, site for field trailer will be on the McClintic's property, pipes and manholes to be delivered this week, saw cutting should be Wednesday, manhole sitting should start next week and Darren stated he is going to request testing be done as the contractor does the project instead waiting to test at the end of the project like the contractor wants to do.

Jeff Smith Wastewater Superintendent brought before the Board the need to replace the influent sampler. B.L. Anderson quote being \$2,749 and Gripp, Inc. being \$7790 for 2 or \$3895 for 1. Jeff ask to go with the lowest being B.L. Anderson.

Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to accept the quote from B. L. Anderson of \$2.749 for an influent sampler. So passed.

Jeff Smith Wastewater Superintendent brought before the Board quotes for the rehabilitation of manholes. Jeff had quotes from Moffitt Rehab Services at \$95 vertical

foot, \$500 flow channel and \$1450 10ft. manhole; Pressure Concrete at \$140 vertical foot, flow channel price included in vertical price and \$1400 10ft. manhole; Halls refused to quote. Jeff recommended to use Pressure Concrete and stated the cost of this project would be approximately \$28,000.

Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to approve the quote of Pressure Concrete for this project of manholes repair. So passed.

Mayor stated that David Wilson has completed one year of probation. **Motion by John Pratt and seconded by Gary Bailey to move David Wilson to first class officer. So passed.**

Meeting adjourned at 9:55 A.M.
