

BOARD OF WORKS MEETING - SPECIAL

JUNE 24, 2008

TIME: 8:00 A.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Gary Herbert and Bill Wenning. Steve Simmonds was absent.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Two board members were present for roll call and one absent.

This is a called emergency Board of Works meeting.

Indot had contracted with the John Jergensen Company to resurface a half portion of the Moscow Road back to its original condition. This road has been used by the big trucks bringing materials over to Indot on the 421 North reconstruction and repavement project with Honda. The portion of Moscow Road from 150 North to 421 North, being resurfaced is owned by the City of Greensburg.

The other half portion of the road needed to be repaved to make the whole road safe. The John Jergensen Company had quoted a cost of \$16,000 to the Street Superintendent to resurface the other half of the road. The company was resurfacing the road within the next couple of days. Street Superintendent Mark Klosterkemper had obtained another quote by phone from Paul H. Rohe Co., Inc. for \$19,885.

Motion by Bill Wenning and seconded by Gary Herbert to approve the John Jergensen Company to resurface the other half portion of Moscow Road to make the road safe and completely back to the original condition with a cost of \$16,000. Ayes Bill Wenning and Gary Herbert. Nays none. So passed.

Fire Chief Scott Chasteen gave an update on the firefighters working out at Honda. They have been out there for 28 days and have responded to 36 calls.
