

COMMON COUNCIL MEETING

JANUARY 07, 2002

TIME: 6:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Gary Bailey, Ed Dwenger, Helen Gardner, David Leas, Herb Hunter and Bruce Tressler.

Minutes were approved with one correction.

Motion by David Leas and seconded by Herb Hunter to nominate Helen Gardner as Council President for the year 2002. So passed.

Motion by Bruce Tressler and seconded by Ed Dwenger to close the nominations. So passed.

Mayor Bailey stated we did not get the Community Development Block Grant the first time around and Resolution 2002-1 is to apply again.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by David Leas to pass Resolution 2001-1 Community Development Block Grant. So passed.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2002-2 Rezoning Jerman Elementary. So passed.

Motion by Bruce Tressler and seconded by David Leas to suspend the rules and regulations. So passed.

Motion by Ed Dwenger and seconded by David Leas to pass on 2nd and 3rd readings Ordinance 2002-2. So passed.

Bruce Tressler told Council members that the Plan Commission Board had approved Larry McCammett's proposal of an 80-unit apartment complex off of Vandalia Road.

Larry McCammett was present and ask that Council approve Ordinance 2002-1 Change of Zoning of Real Estate on all three readings.

Motion by Bruce Tressler and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2002-1 Change of zoning of real estate. So passed.

Motion by Ed Dwenger and seconded by Herb Hunter to suspend the rules and regulations. So passed.

Motion by David Leas and seconded by Ed Dwenger to pass on 2nd and 3rd readings Ordinance 2002-1. So passed.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Ed Dwenger to designate the Greensburg Daily News and Times as the papers for the year 2002. So passed.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by David Leas to pass on 1st reading Ordinance 2002-3 designating depositories. So passed.

Motion by Helen Gardner and seconded by David Leas to suspend the rules and regulations. So passed.

Motion by Ed Dwenger and seconded by Helen Gardner to pass on 2nd and 3rd readings Ordinance 2002-3. So passed.

Herb Hunter gave Council members an update of what went on at the morning Board of Works meeting.

Discussion was held on tax abatement for Daniel and Sandra McLean. This would be on equipment only and since State has changed language to be 1-10 years, Council decided to go with 3 years.

Motion by Herb Hunter and seconded by Bruce Tressler to approve tax abatement for 3years. So passed.

Mayor Bailey stated he has a year-end report from the fire department.

David Leas has been working with Keith Gay Police Chief on a website.

David Leas commended Herb Hunter for being on the Board of Works.
