**Why the Feast of Ascension on Sunday????**

A few years back, the bishops in the western states and in Canada wanted to try celebrating Ascension on Sunday instead of Thursday. Rome approved their plan as an experiment to see if more people would be able to participate in mass if Ascension Day was a Sunday. It worked. So the bishops of the United States discussed whether the whole country should change the celebration of Ascension from a Thursday to a Sunday. They agreed to make the choice by region. Rome approved. So because of this, Ascension Day is Sunday, May 4 the date chosen by the Archdiocese of Indianapolis.

**1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist Celebrations at St. Mary's Parish**

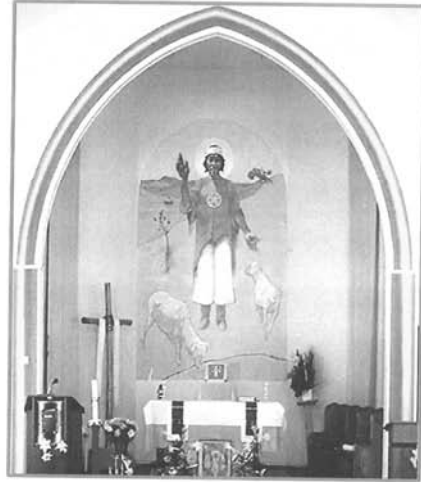
