### **Dear Community,**

I thoroughly enjoyed the summer conference "Strengthened in Hope" at the Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio, across the river from Pittsburgh, Pa. The Ohio River divides the two cities.

I will attend Archdiocesan Convocation with Mass at the Cathedral in Indianapolis at 4:00 p.m. followed by a picnic at Bishop Brute College Seminary at 5:30. We will celebrate and honor the newly ordained.

The last day for our youth minister is July 3. Thank you Andi for your generous service to the youth of our parish.

In today's Gospel, as Jesus restores the daughter of Jairus to life, he gently commands her to rise from her bed. He speaks in his Aramaic language: "Talitha cumi." This is one of the rare occasions when the actual Aramaic words come directly from Jesus to our ears through the scriptures. He says, "Little girl, arise."

The late professor William Barclay surmised in his book *The Gospel of Mark* that "Mark got his information directly from Peter." Mark was writing the Gospel in Greek, but Barclay said that "Peter could never forget Jesus' voice, and in his mind and memory he would hear that Talitha cumi all of his life."

This Aramaic call to life is contrasted with the mournful Aramaic words Jesus spoke in the depths. As Jesus hung from the cross, he cried out: "Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?" Father, why have you forsaken me?

## What do guardian angels do?

Throughout the Bible, there are many accounts of guardian angels providing help and protection to humans. In the life of Jesus, we read about angels protecting Him as an infant, serving Him in the desert, and strengthening Him during His agony in the garden (see Mt 1:20, 2:13, 19:4:11, 26:53; Mk 1:13; Lk 22:43; CCC 333). In the Acts of the Apostles, when Peter was miraculously set free from prison and his friends could not believe it, they commented that the person at the door could not be Peter but that "it must be his angel" (Acts 12:15)

Because our guardian angels are so close to us, we are encouraged to pray to them for their constant intercession and protection in helping lead us to heaven. One of the most treasured prayers recited by children and people of all ages is the prayer that we can each pray to our guardian angel:

"Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love entrusts me here: Ever this day be at my side, to light, to guard, to rule and guide."
